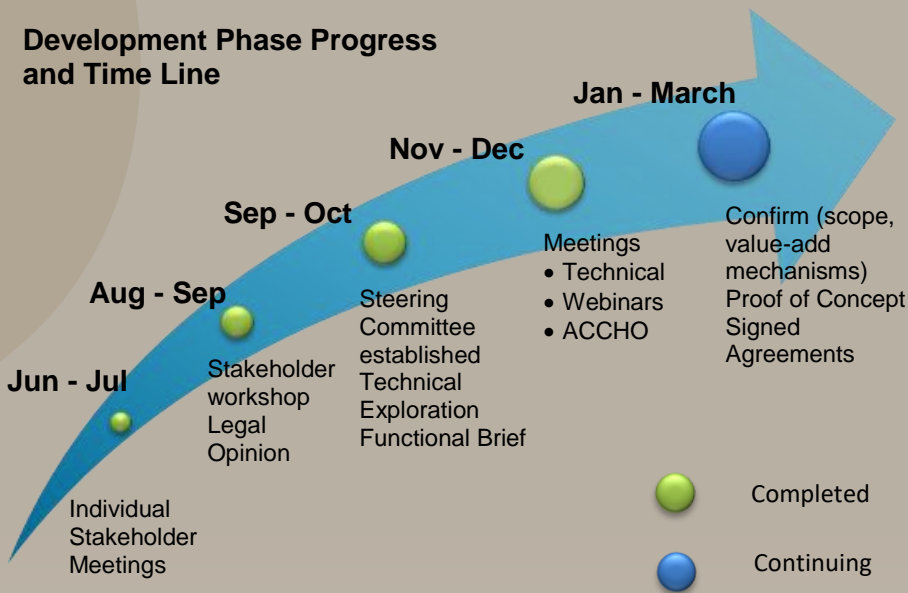
Patient Consent Model

A proposed patient consent model based on legal advice was distributed to stakeholders in November. On the 6th of December, a meeting was held for Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisations to discuss this model and seek feedback. Feedback received will continue to refine this model to ensure it meets the needs of health services who are intending to participate in Territory Kidney Care.

Technical Study

The Technical Study and Functional Overview draft documents have been distributed to technical staff within health services. A technical meeting was held on the 29th of November to discuss the proposed design and seek input from staff who currently support health services with Communicare or Department of Health systems. Early planning for a proof of concept has commenced.
